CIRCULAR

In supersession of Circular No.31/Judl./2022 dated 6th January, 2022, it is hereby notified for information of the Members of the Bar, Party-in-persons' and all concerned that in view of the significant decline in the number of Covid-19 cases and positivity rate, the Competent Authority has been pleased to direct that the Modified Standard Operating Procedure notified on 07.10.2021 for hearing before the Hon'ble Court shall stand revived, and all hearings before the Hon'ble Court w.e.f. 14.02.2022 (Monday) shall be in accordance with the said Modified Standard Operating Procedure notified on 07.10.2021. It is further clarified that :

- (i) Henceforth, all the matters will be listed before the Hon'ble Court as per guidelines.
- (ii) Transfer Petitions of Subject Category – 1802 & 1412 which were being listed before the Regular Benches w.e.f. 07th January, 2022 (Friday) shall now be listed before the Hon'ble Single Judge Bench, as usual.
- (iii) Similarly, the Applications for Exemption from surrendering which were being listed before the Regular Benches from 07th January, 2022 (Friday) will now be listed before the Hon'ble Chamber Judge, as usual.
